"Bianca De Leon is rooted in and lives in two different worlds, the Texas-Mexico borderlands in which she was born and raised...and the national and international singer-songwriter venue circuit.... As always, DeLeon travels first class, with backing by guitar great John Inmon, Radoslav Lorkovic on piano, B3 and accordion, The East Side Flash resophonic guitar, David Carroll bass and Paul Percy drums, on a set that includes a song in Spanish, "Buscando Por Ti," a honky tonker, "The Bottle's On The Table," striking observations on love and loss, "Independence Day," "This Time" and "Silence Speaks Louder Than Words" and ends with a medley of Townes Van Zandt's "Nothin'" and Hank Williams' "Ramblin' Man."
